

ASID CAROLINAS CHAPTER AWARD

PURPOSE:

“Will recognize and honor a member or non-member who had made an outstanding volunteer contribution of significance to the community over a period of years. In addition, this honoree has demonstrated a positive public reflection of the Profession of Interior Design and especially of ASID to the community at large. The Award may be given to an individual or organization based upon a specific action or cumulative service.”

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

➤ This Award is designed to:

- Recognize outstanding volunteer service to the community over a period of years of significant Chapter-wide impact.
- In addition, the nominee should show attention to social concerns within the interior design profession and express creative, innovative concepts that have advanced the profession.
- This Award is also meant to take into consideration service to the Carolinas Chapter and to recognize the relationship between the community as a whole and the volunteer as an ambassador for ASID.

➤ Eligibility:

- An individual
- Multiple individuals
- An industry, or
- An organization

The candidates may be ASID members or non-members and/or groups or organizations.

➤ How To Nominate:

- **MUST** be nominated in **WRITING** by one (1) ASID or IP member **with DETAILED documentation of** their specific action or their cumulative service
- **MUST** be accompanied by **TWO (2) to THREE (3)** supporting members' letters of recommendations, only one of which may come from someone employed by or affiliated with the nominee.
- **NOTE:** *Current Chapter Presidents are **INELIGIBLE** for this award.*
